Wallrock FireLiner produces a very strong base on problem surfaces that cannot be covered by conventional wall coverings, and is also particularly good for covering plaster, plasterboard, insulating wallpapers and thermal boards without having to apply a plaster skim. Once dry, it can be emulsion painted or overhung with another wallcovering.

It is important that all surfaces are free from dust and loose particles. Fill and smooth large cracks or holes, **Wallrock** will bridge any small crack and holes. If the surface is porous eg. plasterboard and old plaster, seal with a size designed for the purpose. For wood panelling, rub down with sandpaper to form a key for the adhesive.

Excessively porous surfaces should be sized with a suitable PVA based bonding solution, whilst smooth impervious surfaces should be roughened slightly.

Use a ready-mixed adhesive. We recommend **Wallrock Power Adhesive** for perfect results, or any good quality heavy duty wallpaper paste. If in doubt, test-hang a piece or consult your decorating retailer. Before hanging, check all rolls are the same product and undamaged, and that you have enough for the job in hand. Return any faulty or damaged roll(s) with their label(s) from where purchased.

Instructions for hanging Wallrock FireLiner

1. Cut all lengths required allowing extra for trim at each end, or simply hang directly from the roll onto a prepasted wall or ceiling. Apply the inner surface to the wall. Please note **Wallrock FireLiner** can also be hung horizontally, especially useful if you intend to overhang with a decorative wallpaper.
2. Mark a guideline with a pencil for the first length, using a plumbline as a guide for vertical drops or a spirit level for horizontal application.
3. If applying the adhesive direct to the wall or ceilings, apply enough to hang one or two lengths at a time, ensuring the paste exceeds the width of the second length. If pasting the material (either side) make sure all edges are covered. With both methods, hang **Wallrock FireLiner** immediately - no soaking is required.
4. Apply the first length along the guideline and smooth out with a wallpaper brush then trim the ends.
5. Butt join all subsequent lengths being careful not to overlap the edges.
6. Allow **Wallrock** to dry thoroughly before decorating with emulsion paint or overhanging with another wallcovering (normally 24 hours is sufficient).
